Eligibility for a Parking Permit

To receive a parking permit, a student must bring the following items:

- Student (students, in the case of carpools) must be present to receive their permit.
- The completed parking permit application (front and back). Permits will not be issued without complete information on the form.
- A current valid driver's license (not a learner's permit).
- A current RHS student ID (ASB) card or a copy of your current RHS schedule.
- The receipt for parking permit. **Permits may not be paid for until the student has a driver's license.**
- Running start and RHS WaNIC students must have a copy of their schedule to show they are eligible for a reduced-price permit.

In addition, all student drivers must meet the following requirements to be eligible for a permit:

- Be a senior, junior or sophomore with no unpaid fines or parking citations.

There are a limited number of parking permits available; payment of the parking permit fee is no guarantee that the student will receive a permit. Priority will be given to seniors. Students may pick up their permits beginning the last week of August in C104. Times for picking up permits will be posted. **Cars without valid permits in the student parking lot will be ticketed starting September 12th. Permits are not transferable between students, including siblings. There are no refunds once the permit is issued.**

Student Parking Permits Fees

The fee plus applicable sales tax for a parking permit must be paid at the bookkeeper's office by check or cash.

Carpool, Running Start, and Motorcycle Permits

All the student drivers as well as their vehicles must be listed on this application form. **Non-drivers, full time running start students or students with learner's permits do not count toward a carpool.** If you purchase a car pool permit you are not eligible to also purchase a regular permit. Students must park in their assigned carpool stall. The vehicles the students drive must display the assigned carpool permit. Permits are not transferable to students who are not part of the carpool.

Full time Running Start students with no classes at RHS and motorcycle riders are eligible for free parking permits, but still must complete and submit this form. Full time Running Start students with permits may only park in the student lot for meetings at RHS. If a student switches from full time Running Start to attending classes at RHS their free permit is no longer valid and they must pay for the appropriate permit to park on campus.

Student Parking and Driving Regulations

Students are responsible for abiding by all the rules on this form. It is recommended that the student driver keep a copy of this form for their records. Additional information is also available on the "Redmond High School Student Parking Permit Information" sheet. Please retain this sheet for your information throughout the year. **Please read and initial each rule below.**

1. All vehicles permitted to park on campus must be registered and have the permit properly affixed in the lower left (driver's) side of your windshield. If you get a new vehicle, see the parking attendant to update your information.

2. If you drive an alternate vehicle, you must display a note with your name, grade and permit number. Failure to display a note with complete information will result in a fine. (Example for note: Jane Doe SR-001)
Fines for violation: \$15 Initial _____
3. Students with SENIOR permits may park in any non-carpool student parking stall. Students with STUDENT permits may only park in the farthest part of the parking lot, located between 104th St NE and the first speed bump. Students may not park in the "No Parking" area of the student lot. Students must park in one stall. Large trucks and SUVs should not park in compact stalls. **Fines for violation \$15 Initial** _____
4. Students may not sell or loan their parking permit to other students including siblings. Students who violate this rule will lose their permit to park on campus and may face other disciplinary action. **Initial** _____
5. All vehicles parked on RHS campus are subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe school policies are violated. **This includes random searches by a certified drug dog.** The LWSD and RHS assume no liability for students driving or parking at RHS. Drivers enter the campus at their own risk. **Initial** _____
6. Do not leave cars in the parking lot overnight without permission from RHS administration. **Fines for violation: \$15 Initial** _____
7. Inappropriate displays on a vehicle in the parking lot are not allowed. **Initial** _____
8. Students are not allowed to eat or loiter in the parking lot or their car. **Initial** _____
9. Students must follow all applicable Washington State Laws when driving or parking at RHS. Drivers must yield to buses and pedestrians. The speed limit is 10 MPH in the parking lot and entrance/exit roads. **Failure to abide by these rules may result in the loss of on-campus parking privileges and/or a \$30 fine. Initial** _____
10. Students who receive a driving violation or three or more parking violations may have their parking permit revoked without a refund and may have their vehicle towed at the owner's expense. **Initial** _____
11. **Students may never drive or park in the staff entrance/parking behind the school or the bus chute. Students may never park in handicapped stalls, in the fire lane or in the drop off lane. Students may not park in STAFF or VISITOR until after 3:00 pm. Failure to abide by these rules may result in the loss of on-campus parking privileges and/or a \$30 fine. Initial** _____
12. Carpool stalls are labeled for carpool parking only. This parking restriction applies during the school day until 2:20 pm. Students parked in the carpool lot without a carpool permit are subject to a fine.

13. Students with carpool permits must display their permit and park in their assigned stall. **Fines for violation: \$15 Initial** _____
14. All students must show student ID when leaving campus. **Initial** _____
15. Questions about parking citations should be brought to the parking attendant within one week of citation date.
