## **AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATING IN RUNNING START 2022-23**

## Carefully read the following before you begin the Running Start program

Enrolling in the Running Start program is big decision which will have a significant impact on a student's high school and college education. It's important for students and parents to understand the following key points regarding enrollment responsibilities and the impact of participation in the Running Start program. Students, please read and initial each line: Students are required to check in quarterly with their counselor. Running Start enrollment requires that students complete a Running Start Enrollment Verification Form (RSEVF) each quarter they are enrolled in the program. Students are responsible for scheduling individual appointments with their counselor to have their RSEVF completed and must submit their form directly to their college before they enroll in their college classes each guarter. Failure to submit the signed RSEVF to the college before registering for classes may result in being charged tuition for all enrolled credits. It is the student's responsibility to ensure that high school graduation requirements are being met. RS students are subject to the same state, district, and school graduation requirements as all Redmond High students. Counselors and information will be available to help guide students, but enrolling in classes that meet graduation requirements, developing a High School and Beyond Plan, and completing a graduation pathway are the responsibility of the student. There is no quarantee that students will be able to register for classes desired at the community college. It will be important to watch for dates and deadlines posted by the college. The earlier you register, the better your chances will be to get your desired classes. Seniors should not wait until spring guarter to take graduation requirements. High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP) activities are required and are to be completed independently. All activities and information will be posted to the HSBP classroom in Microsoft Teams. Students will need to log into Teams at the beginning of the year and should set up email notifications to get updates as activities are posted in Teams. Questions and requests for assistance regarding HSBP activities can be directed to the HSBP Coordinator Ms. Lalas nlalas@lwsd.org. Students are required to activate and regularly check their LWSD student email. LWSD email accounts need to be reactivated every year. Please contact the RHS library if you need assistance with this. Important information, student bulletins, events, and graduation requirements are regularly shared through student email. RS students are eligible to participate in all high school athletics, clubs, and activities. Forgetting to activate or check your LWSD email will not be accepted as an excuse for missing a deadline. Running Start is only funded for up to 15 credits of 100 level or higher college credits per quarter, and students are only funded for up to a 1.2 FTE when combined with high school classes. Students will work with their counselor to determine how many credits they are eligible to take. Students who elect to take additional credits beyond their Running Start funded limit will be responsible for any additional tuition costs. Funding is only available for fall, winter, and spring quarters; summer quarter is not funded. Students who elect to take and pay for summer coursework must provide a copy of their summer transcript to RHS. Books, registration, class required technology or other equipment, lab fees, and parking/transportation fees etc. are also the responsibility of the student. Please let your counselor or college advisor know if this is a concern. Courses numbered 099 or below are not considered part of RS and will not be funded nor counted as college credit; however, these courses may still count for high school credit (please check with your counselor). In order to participate in the Running Start program, students must place into English 101 or higher. In addition, appropriate math scores are required if a student plans to enroll in college level math or science. Algebra 2 is not a college level class and students who have not completed Algebra 2 will have to take the class at RHS or make other arrangements with their counselor to complete this requirement.
