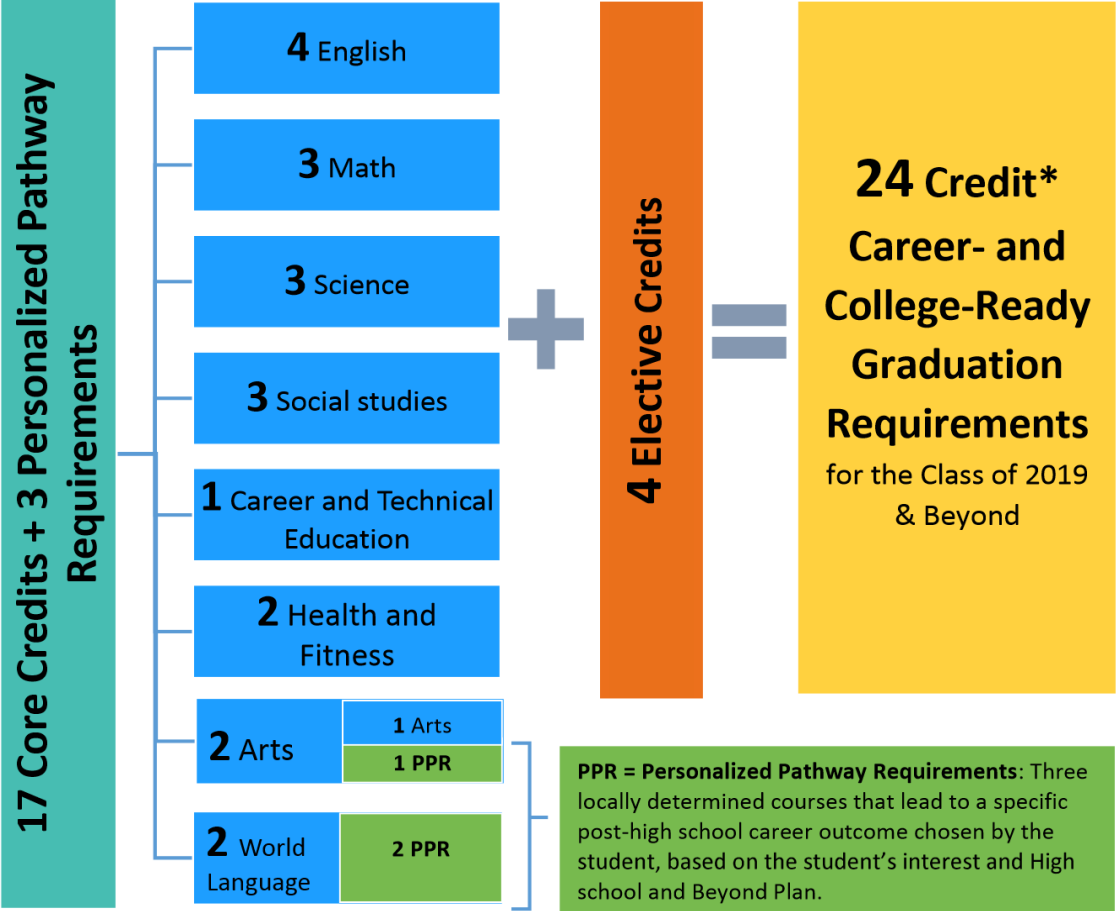
- Identify educational goals related to your career goals


