

## RHS Math Policy on Online Classes

It is possible for students to take online courses to meet the credit requirements or prerequisites. There are some very important conditions.

- (1) Students **MUST** receive credit for EACH of these courses in order to meet state graduation requirements.
- (2) Students need a full 1.0 credit. This is important because sometimes institutions offer two semesters as independent courses. For institutions that offer their classes by semester, BOTH semesters must be taken for the full 1.0 credit to be awarded.
- (3) These credits must be received from an institution accredited to grant high school credits.
- (4) A pre-approval packet must be completed, submitted and approved PRIOR to the course being started. The packet can be found on the RHS Counseling website. The packet needs to be submitted via email to **Mrs. Ilac** (ailac@lwsd.org). Approval comes from the building principal. Upon approval from the principal, the students will be contacted by Mrs. Ilac via email with the “green light” to start the course.
- (5) The course must be completed, and transcripts received by RHS Counseling no later than **August 15<sup>th</sup>**. The course must be completed and transcripts received (sent via mail) by the RHS Counseling or emailed to Data Processor, Megan Livermore (mlivermore@lwsd.org) no later than August 15<sup>th</sup>. This does **NOT** guarantee that there will be space in the course you would like to move into.
- (6) Any fees or tuition for the out of district class are the responsibility of the family.
- (7) Please note that the courses listed below align for the most part with our math courses at RHS.
