

Running Start Equivalency Chart

- Please be sure to meet with your high school counselor for final decision on any class choice. This is for suggestion only and does not replace a quarterly meeting with and approval from your high school counselor.
- Remember, not every class is offered every quarter at each college. It is in your best interest to cover graduation requirements as soon as possible to make sure you do not miss an opportunity to take a class needed for graduation!
- **Courses numbered 099 or below are not considered part of RS and will not be funded nor counted as college credit**, however these courses may still count for high school credit.

Junior/Senior Year High School Subjects	College Equivalent
English	1 five credit English course must be taken in both the junior and senior year
US History	For a full year of high school credit pick one of three – History 146, 147, 148
Civics	Political Science 202
Washington State History	History 214 – please note this is usually only offered 1 quarter per school year so plan accordingly
Health	Health 250, 262, or 292 or other health class as agreed on with high school counselor
Math	Any math class student is eligible for per college requirements (must be over 100 level for RS funds to cover cost)
Science	Any science class student is eligible for per college requirements
World Language	Any language class other than English
PE	Any PE class student is eligible for per college requirements. Please note this can also include dance classes as long as they are not being used for Art credit
Art	Any Art, Theater Art, or Music class student is eligible for per college requirements. Please note this can also include dance classes as long as they are not being used for PE credit
Occupational	Any Business, Computer, Technical, or other occupational class as agreed on with high school counselor
Electives	Any class student is eligible for per college requirements that is not going to a specific high school requirement

- There are three quarters per school year (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- Full time RS students are eligible for 15 tuition free credits per quarter
- The number of tuition free credits part time students are eligible for is dependent on the number of courses enrolled in at high school
